INVITATION TO JOIN THE BOTSWANA DEFENCE FORCE

LIMITED VACANCIES FOR SPECIAL ENTRANT OFFICER CADETS

Potential Candidates should possess a Bachelor's or a Master's degree from recognised institutions/universities in the following professions:

- 1. Medical Specialists, Aviation Medicine Specialists, Clinical Psychologists, Clinical Social Workers, Bio-medical Engineers, Radiographers, Physiotherapists, Dieticians, Pharmacists, Audiologists and Specialist Nurses (Anesthetists, Trauma and Theatre etc.).
- 2. Law (Prosecutors, Magistrates, Trial or Litigation Lawyers, Environmental Lawyers, Property or Real Estate Lawyers, and Administrative Lawyers).
- 3. Chaplains (Ordained Ministers).
- 4. Industrial Psychologists, Statisticians, Policy Specialists.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- a. Botswana citizens, both males and females.
- b. Should be in possession of a valid National ID card (Omang).
- c. Aged under 40 years.
- d. Be physically and mentally fit.
- e. No adverse criminal records.
- f. Minimum height of 160 cm for males and 155 cm for females.
- g. Minimum body weight of 55 Kg for males and 45 Kg for females.
- h. All candidates shall undergo the selection process as prescribed under the selection process.
- i. Female candidates must not be pregnant at recruitment.
- j. Minimum of six (6) years' work experience.
- k. Registered and licensed to practice with relevant statutory bodies.
- I. Chaplains should also be ecclesiastically endorsed.

NB: Botswana Defence Force has established Mobile Recruitment Centres in the following areas; Gantsi, Maun, Francistown, Palapye and Gaborone as the Main Centre. It is therefore compulsory that candidates indicate their place of preference in their applications.

- b. Comprehensive medical examination in accordance with BDF Recruitment Medical Standards.
- c. Aptitude test, interviews and group tests.

MANDATORY TRAINING:

Successful candidates shall undergo 12 months Officer Cadet Basic Military Training before commissioning as Officers. On completion of training, Officers must be ready to serve in various geographic locations and environmental conditions.

Certified copies of National Identity Card (Omang), relevant educational certificates/documents, transcripts, CV and references must be attached.
